GLCC goals

As the international voice of lung cancer patients, the Global Lung Cancer Coalition is committed to improving outcomes for all by placing the disease squarely on the international health agenda.

We provide information to help patients and their loved ones.

We also supply, evaluate and collate data to support research and effect changes in legislation and regulatory policies to optimise the treatment and care of people with lung cancer.

We have developed an interactive e-Atlas - an accessible online tool for researchers seeking to use

comparative data about the disease within member nations.

Data concerning public awareness, attitudes, and perceptions of lung cancer is collated from international consumer surveys.

The GLCC Newsletter provides regular updates of work carried out by member organisations worldwide.

We will accomplish our mission by ensuring that policy makers, medical professionals, the media and the general public recognise the serious nature of lung cancer and the need for immediate action to meet patient needs.

Who can join?

Membership of the GLCC is voluntary and for patient and professional organisations dedicated to improving lung cancer patient outcomes.

Membership is open to registered non-government, patient and professional organisations involved in the advocacy, support and care for lung cancer patients.

Generic cancer and respiratory organisations are also eligible for membership, if they have a clear lung cancer patient focus to their activities.

GLCC members

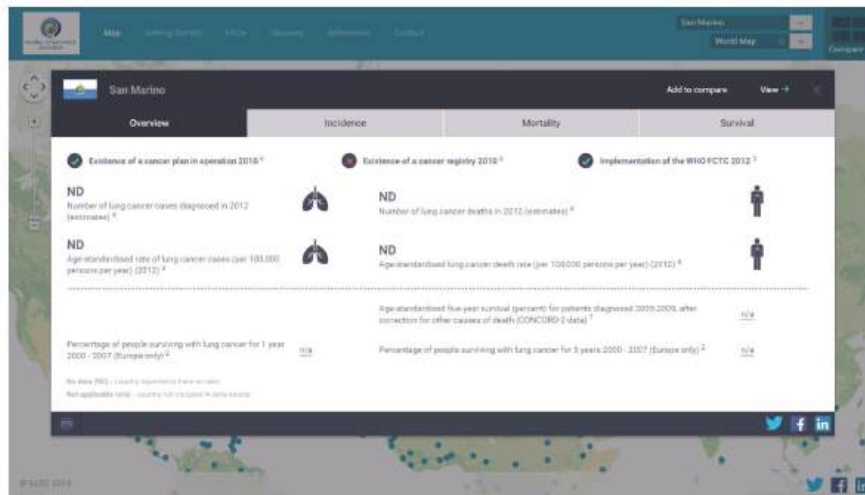


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Established in 2001, the GLCC is comprised of non-government patient organisations from Africa, Asia, Australia/Oceania, Europe, North America and South America.
