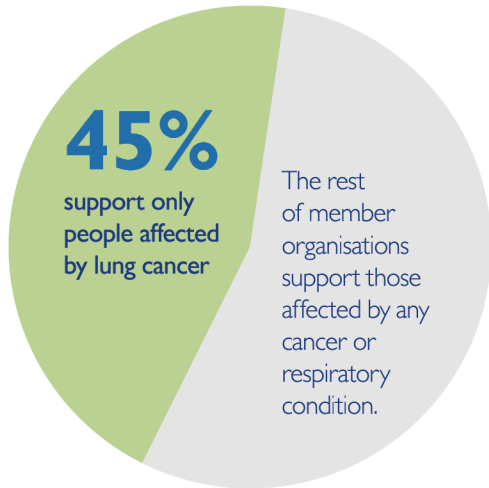


GLCC COPING WITH LUNG CANCER SURVEY

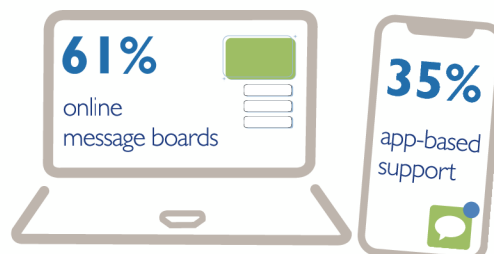
